Eligible Art	This competition is open to original photographic images, either film or digital, depicting some aspect of the Carolinas. Artists may enter up to three (3) pieces of work (in any category), with separate application and entry fee for each entry.
Categories	View Scapes, Nature, Pictorial
Prizes will be issued for:	
• Best of Show	\$200.00
• 1 st Place Each Category	\$100.00
• 2 nd Place Each Category	\$50.00
Application/Art Delivery	November 29 & November 30. All work must be delivered between 9:00 am – 5:00 pm <u>to the Arts Council</u> . A completed application form, entry fee and (<i>optional</i>) artist statement must accompany each entry. No late entries allowed.
Opening Reception	Friday, December 3 from 5:30 – 8:00 pm. The reception – and the exhibition – are free and open to the public and <u>will be at First Citizens Bank.</u>
Show Closes	Friday, December 24.
Art Pick-Up	All work must be picked up Tuesday, December 28 or Wednesday, December 29 from 9:00 am – 5:00 pm <u>at First Citizens Bank</u> . Remaining art will be moved to the Arts Council's new office, 401 North Main Street (Community Foundation of Henderson County office suite). Artwork not picked up by January 14, 2011 will become property of The Arts Council of Henderson County. Note: <i>Special arrangements for other pick-up dates will be considered by calling (828) 693-8504 <u>before the close of the exhibition.</u></i>

Jury and Judging Show

- All artwork entries will be juried. If your work is selected, it will then be displayed and judged. If your work is not accepted by the Jury, you will be notified by email or phone. All work not accepted must be picked up December 8 or December 9, 9:00 am – 5:00 pm at First Citizens Bank or it will become property of The Arts Council of Henderson County.

Category Definitions

- **View Scapes** – Includes landscapes, seascapes, cloudscapes, cityscapes, etc. representing identified Carolina locations.
- **Nature** – More selective, intimate views of the myriad elements of nature – not a grand view of nature as described under “View Scapes”. The subject should be “natural,” that is, the “hand of man” should not be included in the frame.
- **Pictorial** – Images that do not fall into the above categories. Could include a pattern, texture or abstract shot. Must be identified as a Carolina subject/object.

Art Requirements/Jury Criteria

- Artwork must have been created, not just printed, within the last two years.
- All artwork must be delivered ready to display. This includes framed or matted, with wire or hanging tabs securely attached.
- All artwork must be for sale and priced accordingly.
- All artwork must be original to the photographer.
- Artists may choose to provide an artist statement and/or biography. The Arts Council prefers these to be submitted as an electronic version (preferably Word format) or on a CD.
- Artists may enter more than one piece in a category provided a separate application and fee is received for each entry.
- Artists may enter artwork in more than one category, provided a separate application and fee is received for each entry.
- A completed application form and entry fee must accompany each piece of artwork submitted.

Waiver of Liability

All reasonable care will be taken with artwork. Artists must sign a waiver of liability at time of delivery.

Application Fee

- \$20 fee per entry.
- Arts Council of Henderson County Members will pay no fee for the first entry and will pay \$10 for each subsequent piece entered.

Commission

- The Arts Council of Henderson County receives a 30% commission on all sales.

- All exhibited artwork will be marked with the price set by the artist.

Photographic Rights

- The Arts Council of Henderson County reserves the right to photograph the show for the purposes of documentation, education and publicity.

Volunteering
