- Eligible Art** This competition is open to original works of art in wood and paintings or 2-D wall art with trees or similar wood related subject. Artists may enter up to three (3) pieces of work per category, with separate application and entry fee for each entry.
- Categories** Carved, Turned, Constructed, 2-D Wall Art
- Prizes will be issued for:**
- Best of Show \$200.00
 - 1st Place Each Category \$100.00
 - 2nd Place Each Category \$50.00
- Application/Art Delivery** May 27 & May 28. All work must be delivered between 9:00 am – 5:00 pm. A completed application form, entry fee and artist statement must accompany each entry. **No late entries allowed.**
- Opening Reception** Friday, June 4 from 5:30 – 8:00 pm. The reception – and the exhibition – are free and open to the public.
- Show Closes** Saturday, July 3.
- Art Pick-Up** All work must be picked up Tuesday, July 6 or Wednesday, July 7 from 9:00 am – 5:00 pm. Artwork not picked up by July 23 will become property of The Arts Council of Henderson County.
Note: *Special arrangements for other pick-up dates will be considered by calling (828) 693-8504 before the close of the exhibition.*

Jury and Judging Show

- All artwork entries will be juried. If your work is selected, it will then be displayed and judged. If your work is not accepted by the Jury, you will be notified by email or phone. All work not accepted must be picked up June 8 or June 9, 9:00 am – 5:00 pm or it will become property of The Arts Council of Henderson County.

Category Definitions

- **Carved** – Original wood artwork that is created using knives, chisels, gouges or similar hand tools. Artwork may include sculptures or other decorative pieces, utensils and related items. (Use of machines/power tools and/or laminated stock is not permitted.)
- **Turned** – Original wood artwork that is created with the only power tool/machine being used is a lathe or similar equipment to manipulate the wood into desired design forms. Hand tools may be used if desired. Pieces may include musical instruments, tableware, kitchen items or other pieces. (Use of laminated stock is permitted in this category.)
- **Constructed** – Original wood artwork that has been constructed using machines/power tools or related equipment to build desired design forms from the wood. Pieces may include furniture, sculpture, wall hangings and related artwork. (Use of laminated stock is permitted in this category.)
- **2-D Wall Art** – Original paintings of trees or closely related wood oriented subject. 2-D art may be textured or have dimensionality as long as it designed to be hung on a wall.

Art Requirements/Jury Criteria

- Artwork must have been created within the last two years.
- All artwork must be delivered ready to display. This includes framed or matted, with wire or hanging tabs securely attached.
- All artwork must be for sale and priced accordingly.
- All artwork must be original and one-of-a-kind. (No production pieces except in the “Turned/Constructed Functional” category.)
- All artwork must be largely created by the artist. (No construction from purchased kits.)
- All artwork must be produced by the artist/s. (Collaboration of two or more artists is permitted. Artwork designed by the artist and “manufactured/produced” by other workers/assistants is not permitted.)
- Due to space limitations, size of artwork will be a factor in jurying.
- Artists must provide an electronic version (Word format) of artist statement, biography and any additional information requested for each entry.
- Artists may enter more than one piece in a category provided a separate application and fee is received for each entry.
- Artists may enter artwork in more than one category, provided a separate application and fee is received for each entry.
- A completed application form, artist statement and entry fee must accompany each piece of artwork submitted.

Waiver of Liability

All reasonable care will be taken with artwork. Artists must sign a waiver of liability at time of delivery.

Jurying Fee

- \$20 fee per entry.
- Arts Council of Henderson County Members will pay no fee for the first entry and will pay \$10 for each subsequent piece entered.

Commission

- The Arts Council of Henderson County receives a 30% commission on all sales.
- All exhibited artwork will be marked with the price set by the artist.

Photographic Rights

- The Arts Council of Henderson County reserves the right to photograph the show for the purposes of documentation, education and publicity.

All exhibiting artists will be listed on the Arts Council website and included in the publicity campaign. Artist's website will be linked to the "WOOD!" page on the Council's website.
