Art Teachers Create is the second annual exhibition presented by artists and art teachers who provide art instruction to Henderson County students, and is part of the thematic unit, *Mentors & Students*.

Art Teachers Create is open to art teachers in public, private and parochial schools, home-school arts associations or co-ops, and private art teachers in Henderson County who have children eligible to participate in either the elementary or secondary student exhibitions. Student teachers may also participate.

The two other exhibitions that are part of *Mentors & Students* are *The Art of Our Children – Elementary School Exhibit (February 25 – March 11)* and *Vision 2011 – Artists of Tomorrow (Senior and Middle School Students) (April 8 – 22)*.

Interest Notification: Please call or email The Arts Council by Friday, February 11 to indicate your interest in participating in this show. This will help us with our planning activities.

Fees & Commission: The Arts Council is waiving the usual entry fee for all artists in this show. Artists who are members of the Arts Council will be allowed to submit more pieces than those who are not members of the Arts Council. There will be a 30% commission on every sale for The Arts Council. Artists will receive payment

for all sold work approximately one week after the exhibition closes.

- Media: All media accepted. *All art must be available for purchase.*
- Number of Pieces: A maximum of **8** pieces may be submitted by each art teacher who is a current member of the Arts Council. Non-members may submit **2** pieces. (Artist memberships range from \$40 - \$60; visit our website or call for more information. *You may also join at the time you deliver your work.*)
- Presentation: All 2D work must be matted and framed or, gallery -wrapped canvas. All work must be prepared for hanging. *Maximum size: 3' wide x 4' high.*
- All 3D work will be exhibited on pedestals as appropriate. All large sculpture must be able to stand alone or come with an included support system.
- Space may be limited for larger pieces.***
- Delivery: All work shall be delivered to First Citizens Bank on **Monday or Tuesday, March 14 or 15 between 1:00 – 4:45 pm** with a completed application for each piece submitted.
- Labels: Each piece must have the following information attached: **Artist Name, Title, Media, Price.** *There is a form below the application that you may cut and attach.* An optional artist statement or biography may also be submitted in hard copy at that time (or you can send electronically to info@acofhc.org).
- Also email an inventory list to info@acofhc.org for all submitted work with name, title, media, price no later than **Tuesday, March 15.** An Excel document is available from your Curriculum Supervisor or by calling 828.693.8504 or emailing info@acofhc.org. *The Arts Council will make exhibition labels.*
- Installation: **Wednesday, March 16.** *(Arts Council Installation Committee will provide this service)*
- Pick -up: All work shall be picked up on **Monday or Tuesday, April 4 or 5, from 1:00 - 4:45 pm** at First Citizens Bank. Work not removed by **Friday, April 8** will become the property of The Arts Council.

Liability

*All reasonable care will be taken with the art; work is entered at the risk of the artist. Neither the Arts Council, nor its representatives nor First Citizens Bank can be held responsible for any loss or damage to your work from any cause. Submitting a work of art shall imply an agreement on the part of the artist to the conditions set forth in this prospectus. **Artists will be asked to sign a Waiver when art is delivered.***
