2019 Mentors & Students Exhibitions

Hendersonville, NC - The Arts Council of Henderson County will present a series of exhibitions as a thematic unit entitled Mentors & Students at First Citizens Bank, 539 N. Main St., Hendersonville, NC. Celebrating the importance of art in a child's life, the three exhibitions will feature the work of Henderson County elementary students, secondary students, and their art mentors.

Art Teachers Create, the second show in the series, will feature the artwork of Henderson County's art teachers. The exhibition will open with a reception on Friday, March 1, from 5:30 to 7:00pm. The show will close Friday, March 8. All artwork will be for sale during the Mentors exhibition. The public will have a chance to win a piece of art from this show in a free raffle sponsored by Woodlands Gallery, 419 N. Main St., Hendersonville. The winning name will be drawn at the end of the series on March 22.

Secondary students will be featured in the third show of the series, *Artists of Tomorrow*, opening Friday, March 15, from 5:30 to 7:00pm, and closing Friday, March 16. The opening will include the announcement of awards, which will include a Best of Show Award of \$150, sponsored and presented by the Art League of Henderson County. In addition to announcement of the awards, the public will learn which piece of art will appear on an ArtScape Hendersonville banner for a year starting in April 2019.

Hours for all exhibitions will be Monday through Thursday 9:00am to 5:00pm, and Fridays from 9:00am to 6:00pm. All exhibitions will be held at First Citizens Bank's Main Street Gallery at 539 N. Main St., Hendersonville. The exhibitions are free, open to the public, and handicapped accessible.

39 ARTISTS CHOSEN FOR 2019 ARTSCAPE BANNERS

(HENDERSONVILLE, NC, February 4, 2019) – Thirty-nine artworks were recently chosen by a two-person jury for the upcoming 2019 ArtScape Banner Project. The current outdoor exhibit of art banners

displayed on light posts in downtown Hendersonville and along Historic 7th Avenue will come down in March to be replaced by the recently-chosen artists' works. The jurors – Susan Leidy and James V. Langer – chose the collection of new works from 171 submissions by local artists in various mediums – from oil and acrylic paintings, to 3-D sculpture, quilting, mixed-media, and more. The new show will hang along streets and avenues from April this year to March 2020.

One more banner – to be chosen from applicants in the youth category – will make a total of 40 art banners for the 2019 exhibit. The young-artist winner will be named soon.

The Jurors

Juror Susan Leidy is Deputy Director of Collections and Exhibitions at Chrysler Museum of Art, Norfolk, Virginia. Previously serving at the Currier Museum of Art as Deputy Director, she was responsible for major exhibitions, visitor services, security, and facilities projects, including the museum's 2008 \$21.4 million expansion. Educated at Dickinson College, the University of Pennsylvania, and Boston University, she has also worked at the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts, Yale Center for British Art, and National Trust for Historic Preservation and directed the Washington D.C. office for the international auction house Sotheby's.

Juror James V. Langer is Chair of Greensboro College Department of Art and is a Professor of Art at GC. Jim has a B.F.A. from Boston University and M.F.A. from the University of North Carolina at Greensboro. Well-versed and accomplished in the traditions of Western drawing and painting, especially life drawing and anatomy, he also has considerable knowledge of the ink paintings of East Asia, such as zengai. He teaches Drawing, the Figure, Painting, 2-D Design/Illustration, Experimental Studio, Western Art History surveys, and Asian/African/Indigenous Art History.

Opening Reception for 2019 ArtScape Exhibit

The public is invited to the 2019 celebration/ reception/opening exhibition on Friday, April 5, from 5 to 7:30 p.m., to be held concurrently in two downtown locations within easy walking distance of each other – at Art Mob Studios & Marketplace, 124 4th Avenue East, and at Woodlands Gallery, 419 N. Main St. in Hendersonville.

The artists and the sponsors of the new banners will attend at both locations, and the original artwork depicted on the 2019 banners will be on sale. Live music, appetizers, and drinks will be provided at both locations. Recently-removed banners in the 2018 ArtScape Banner Project will be handed to the sponsors during the reception.

The project's objective is to create an outdoor gallery experience making Hendersonville an exciting and unique art destination. The ArtScape Hendersonville committee formed as a result of collaboration between the Art League of Henderson County, the Arts Council of Henderson County, and Downtown Hendersonville, Inc. ArtScape Hendersonville received funding from the Community Foundation of Henderson County and Henderson County Tourism Development Authority.

During last year's *Creative Kenmure* exhibit, countless people asked if the works on display were available for purchase. As you know, *Creative Kenmure* was not a sales event – but all those questions have resulted in a “spin-off” event that will give everybody the chance to browse and buy beautiful handmade items.

The ***Kenmure Artisan Marketplace*** will feature talented artisans selling their original handmade wares in the Charleston Room from **11am to 2pm on Wednesday, July 10, 2019**. As a Creative Kenmure participant, we wanted you to be one of the first to hear about it!

What will be sold?

Ceramics, needle art, sculpture, wood, jewelry, paintings... we're very much hoping a variety of artisans will offer a broad array of unique items for sale.

Who will be selling?

Experienced sellers - some of us already sell in crafts shows, galleries, and shops - we hope many of you will participate.

Hobbyists who've never sold before - we encourage you to take this easy and convenient opportunity to sort through your stash, get a table, and sell! There's no better way to make space at home for future creativity...

Collaborators – organize your artisan friends and share a table, either splitting the profits OR donating your proceeds to your favorite charity.

Artisans need not be Kenmure residents to participate – so please share this information with other artists and crafters whose work you admire throughout Henderson County and beyond.

How is this going to work?

Artisan “booths” will consist of linen-draped rectangular tables available in two sizes, as shown below. Floor space per table will be about 10'x10'. Non-profit participants will pay half the regular table fees.

More than one table may be reserved, if desired. The table fees will be paid to Kenmure Country Club to cover room set up and cleaning expenses. No further fees will be required. Artisans keep all sale proceeds.

- \$40 for 6'x30" rectangular table
- \$50 for 8'x30" rectangular table

Participants are responsible for conducting their own transactions and must supply and set up their own display props, easels, etc. Set up will start at 8:00am on July 10; specific arrival times will be assigned later.

What about painters (or others) with large pieces to sell?

We can push your tables to the side or remove them altogether so you can fill your 10'x10' areas with your own floor easels/displays. (Art cannot be hung on walls.) We'll help you create a good selling space.

When and How do I sign up?

Application deadline is June 10, 2019 – however – applications are being accepted NOW. In mid-March, the application and photo reviews will begin. Successful applicants will be contacted shortly thereafter and/or within 1-2 weeks of application receipt. Table fees will be requested at that time.






