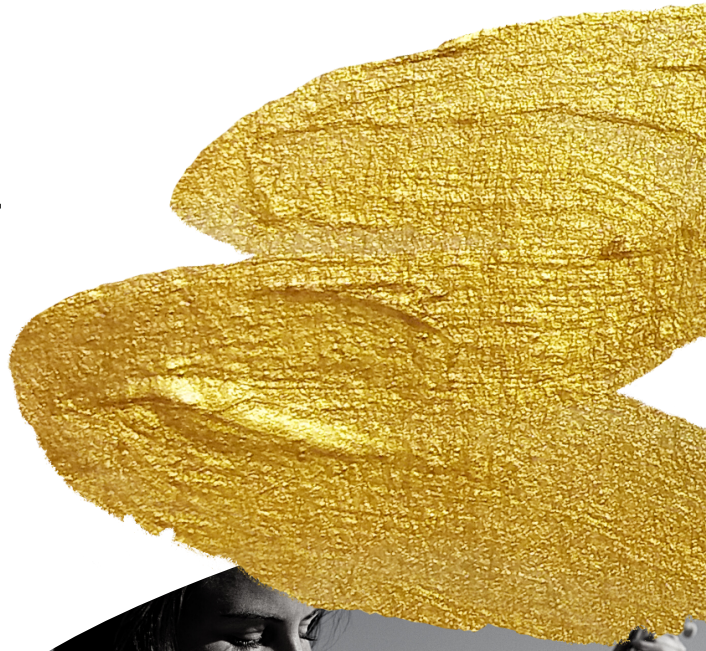

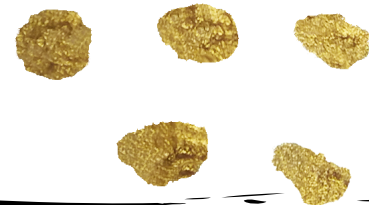


Bring Us Your Best | August 15-20
